This booklet was designed as a guide to help you with accessing golf events; understanding the basic golf rules and guidelines for play; and providing helpful information. For more comprehensive and detailed information, Members are encouraged to refer to the StoneWater Golf Club Member Handbook.

THE SEASON

The season runs from May 1, 2024 and ends on October 31, 2024.

GUESTS OF MEMBERS

All guests will be required to check in with the Golf Shop and register their name into the system as a guest player. Guests will be permitted to play three (3) times at the Member Guest Rate during member peak times. Rounds members may use their rounds for guest play with the exception during Peak Times: Friday 11:00 A.M – 3:00, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays before 12 Noon. Members may bring up to 3 guests during Peak Times.

SIGNING UP FOR MEMBER EVENTS

Members may sign up for Events by signing up online through Golf Genius or by calling or stopping into the pro shop. Other than the Invitational, Members may sign-up for any of the events at any time throughout the season.

TEE TIMES (In Season Hours)

Members can schedule tee times 2 weeks in advance and non-Members can schedule tee times 1 week in advance. Tee times can be scheduled by calling the pro shop or through the website or Member Portal. The Golf Shop will always make a best effort to get Members without tee times onto the course, but it cannot be guaranteed, and it is always best to have a tee time. Unless otherwise posted, all play will tee off from #1 tee unless prior approval from the Golf Shop is received. Generally, in-season, the first tee time weekdays is 8:00 AM and 7:00 AM on weekends and holidays. Circumstances, including outings and Member events, may require modifications to tee times.

PRACTICE RANGE

The practice range at StoneWater is available to members anytime and guests prior to their round. Hours of operation are as follows:

Monday

Opens 30 minutes before first tee time.
Range closes at 6:00 PM to allow for maintenance.

Tuesday-Sunday

Opens 30 minutes before first tee time.
Range closes at 8:00 PM or 1 hour before sunset.

2024 USGA HANDICAP PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

Handicaps for golf club Members will be computed using the guidelines established by the USGA. The basic premise of the USGA handicapping system assumes, “that every player will try to make the best score at each hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played, and that the player will post every acceptable round for peer review.”

The USGA announced the World Handicap System in 2020, which was updated in 2024. Here are a few things to keep in mind and understand about system:

1. Daily Update

You will now be able to see your updated numbers daily after posting a score.

2. Get Your Handicap established sooner.

You will be able to enter fewer rounds to receive your Handicap Index. The system will only require 5. Also, the new World Handicap System will take your best 8 scores of your most recent 20.

3. Keep Your Scores Low

The World Handicap System will now have a maximum hole score. Capping it at net double bogey, this system will keep your score closer to your true playing potential.

4.Improvements have been made to the method used to handle holes not played, which will now be based on a player’s expected score rather than a score of net par. This new method will produce a 9-hole or 18-hole Score Differential that more accurately reflects a player’s ability. As golfers across the world are playing more 9-hole rounds, an expected score can also be used to convert a 9-hole round into an 18-hole Score Differential. For some countries, this means that 9-hole scores will be considered in the calculation of a player’s Handicap Index immediately after the day of play, rather than waiting to combine with another 9-hole score.

5. Blame the Weather.

As with most outside events and sports, the weather is unpredictable and can play a huge role in how well, or how poorly, you play. The Playing Conditions Calculation (PCC) has been modified to increase the likelihood of an adjustment for abnormal playing conditions. The system will take into account the weather on your course and adjust your score accordingly, making it very important to post score on the same day round is played to have any weather adjustments computed.

6. Everyone gets a Handicap Index.

It's better to have everyone establish a Handicap Index, even if you're a first-time golfer. Thanks to this system, that will now be possible and less intimidating. The maximum Handicap will be 36.4 for men and 54 for women.

GOLF CART ACCESS AND FEES

All Members have the option to purchase an Unlimited Cart Lease allowing them unlimited use of a golf cart at any time of play. Members who opt NOT to purchase the cart lease and guests will pay for the use of a golf cart any time they use one, regardless of the number of holes played. Golf cart fees are \$34 for 18-holes and \$17 for 9-holes plus tax. The fees are also published in the Golf Shop and on the StoneWater website and are the price listed plus sales tax. Juniors are permitted to take a golf cart provided they are 16 years old with a Driver's License and have the consent of the golf shop staff. **To cover the cost of extra carts and maintenance a \$10.00 surcharge per 18-hole round will be added if a player prefers to take a single cart. This surcharge will also apply to individuals with an unlimited cart lease.**

GOLF CART GPS & USB CHARGING

Our E-Z-GO golf cart fleet is equipped with Pace Technology GPS units. The Pace GPS System is innovative and focuses on optimizing and amplifying your golf experience. You will be given accurate GPS distances, hole layouts and pin placements. You will, as well, be able to communicate with the Pro Shop, and vice versa, in regard to pace of play and severe weather notifications. The units also offer digital scoring and ability to stream your phone music through the system. The carts are also equipped with USB charging ports. Charging cords can be purchased in the pro shop.

GOLF CART GPS GEO-FENCING

The golf cart geo-fencing has the capability to prevent golf carts from entering restricted areas including par 3 fairway and rough areas, any area too close to greens or tees, ground under repair areas and will prevent carts from leaving the cart path when golf course condition requires cart path only. If a cart shuts down when entering a restricted area, put cart in reverse and exit area the same way that you entered and golf cart will be able to go forward and run properly once you are clear of restricted area.

WALKING POLICY & TRAIL FEES

Golfers may be allowed to carry clubs during play or use a pushcart. A trail fee will be charged to walkers. Peak time fees are \$20 for 18-holes and \$10 for 9-holes. Non-peak time fees are \$12 for 18-holes and \$6 for 9-holes. If the group cannot keep pace with the group ahead of them, they will be requested to use a golf cart for the remainder of the round, with the applicable cart fees incurred. In the vicinity of tee boxes and greens, push carts should remain in the rough, away from the greens, collars and bunkers.

PRO SHOP MERCHANDISE

Members will receive a minimum of 10% off in-stock Golf Shop merchandise through-out the year excluding golf balls, clubs and hard goods. We stock the latest golf clubs and apparel from all of the leading manufacturers including Titleist, FootJoy, Callaway, Ping, Johnnie O, AHEAD, Under Armour, Sun Mountain, Straight Down and TaylorMade to name a few. Special orders are also available.

GOLF LESSONS

Golf lessons are available with our PGA Professionals. All lessons are by appointment only. Lesson packages are available at a reduced price. Appointments can be made by calling the golf shop at 440-461-4653 or by booking online using our Uschedule platform. Which can be found in the Linksman Golf Academy Tab on the StoneWater website, following these few steps:

- Click the learn more button under the title Book Lessons Online, this will take you to the Uschedule website.

The lesson fees vary by PGA Professional, by length of the lesson and whether the lesson is individual or group.

CLUB FITTING AT THE LINKSMAN HOUSE

The Linksman House is our state-of-the-art golf club fitting facility located at the range at StoneWater. We have the ability to custom fit the complete set of golf clubs from the driver to putter using the latest Trackman technology. We carry the leading golf club manufacturers including Titleist, Taylor Made, Callaway and Ping. You can book an appointment by calling the golf shop at 440-461-4653 or by booking online using our Uschedule platform. LINKSMAN HOUSE SIMULATORS

Brand new in 2023, the Linksman House is fully enclosed and heated with state-of-the-art Trackman simulators and 2 indoor bays that will be used for club fitting and teaching. Members may schedule bays for practice or playing simulator golf on the world's finest golf courses. Linksman House also has 3 covered bays that can be opened to allow golfers to hit into practice range.

HOLE IN ONE CLUB

The Member Hole-in-One Club is a fee of \$5.00 charged to all members. The total value of the fund is paid out in Golf Shop or Rustic Grill credit when a member records a Hole-In-One. The \$5.00 is billed to new members upon joining and re-billed after every Hole-in-One. All members participate in the Hole-in-One Club.

DRESS CODE

All golfers, including guests, must wear proper golf attire on the course, practice greens and driving range at all times. Acceptable attire for men includes Bermuda shorts, pants/slacks/knickers. Shirts must have a collar (mock acceptable) and should be tucked in. Accepted attire for women includes slacks, skirts, shorts – must be at least mid-thigh in length; conventional shirts or tops as available in any Golf Shop. All caps/hats must be worn in the traditional manner. Denim (jean) material in any form will not be permitted in-season. StoneWater requires the use of soft spikes while on the golf course, practice greens or practice range. Members are responsible to alert guests of this rule.

PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES

Your objective at all times on the golf course should be to keep up with the group ahead of you. If your group is directly in position behind the group ahead of you, you are accomplishing one of your responsibilities to the other golfers on the course. StoneWater Golf Club's expected pace for a foursome is 4 Hours and 15 Minutes (i.e., 2 hours 5 minutes front 9, 5 minutes for the turn, 2 hours and 5 minutes back 9. With the addition of GPS on the carts, keeping up with the pace of play will be much easier for you to follow.

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Each player is urged to maintain the course and leave it in better condition than they found it. If everyone follows these guidelines, all players will gain maximum enjoyment from the game and especially the course. Members are responsible for their guests. Listed below are the most important common etiquette practices that the Management of StoneWater Golf Club asks its Members and their guests to follow at all times.

1. In fairways, players should always replace divots, if not doable fill in divots with sand mix.
2. On greens, to ensure no damage is caused to the putting surface or to the hole, please repair ball marks and damage caused by clubs and shoes. The head of a club should not be used to remove ball from hole. Do not drop the flagstick on putting surface.

3. Players should enter and leave bunkers from the shallowest point and not on the slopes of bunkers. All holes and footprints should be filled by raking and smoothing them over. Climbing over the face of the bunker should be avoided to prevent damage to the turf. Before proceeding, leave rake head inside the bunker and the handle outside and at low area of bunker.
4. Players must follow cart paths and direction signs when encountered on the golf course for both safety and maintenance reasons. Carts are to be kept on the path at all times around tees, putting greens, and on all Par 3's. On the course, use cart paths whenever possible. During wet ground conditions posted as "cart path only", carts are not allowed off existing cart paths at any time reinforced by GPS geo-fencing technology.
5. Pedestrian walking, jogging, and biking are NOT permitted on the Club property at any time without permission of management.
6. Respect each other and staff and behave in a courteous and professional manner.
7. No outside food or beverages are permitted at any time.

MONTHLY MEMBER BILLING

In 2024 we will implement a new billing system that will necessitate members to have a credit card on file. If current account balances are not paid by the 15th of the month, members account balances will be charged to the credit card on file. Only members with a current credit card on file will be able to have charging privileges.

Monthly Member statements will be posted on the member portal on the StoneWater website on the 1st day of the month. This monthly billing consists of any charges made to your account in the Golf Shop or in the restaurant during the prior month. All bills are due and payable upon receipt. All checks should be made payable to Water Golf, LTD., and either mailed to One Club Drive, Highland Heights, Ohio 44143 or dropped off at the Pro Shop.

If you have any changes to your Member profile including address or phone number, you can make them directly through the Member portal. If you have any specific billing questions or issues with the portal, please call the administrative office at 440-461-4653, ext. 110.

FAILURE TO PAY TIMELY

The following are the implications of a Member failing to pay their bill in a timely manner.

- All charges are in arrears and all bills are due upon posting in the Member portal on the 1st day of the month.
- A bill not paid by the end of the month is considered past due and will be assessed a charge of 1.5% per month.
- A Member whose bill is 30 day's delinquent will have all charging privileges for the Member and their family revoked. This would apply, for example, to a bill issued on the 1st of July that was unpaid as of August 31.
- A Member whose bill is 60 day's delinquents will have all privileges for the Member and their family revoked and the rights of any person or persons entitled to use the Club may be terminated for conduct unbecoming a Member. This would apply, for example, to a bill covering the period ended June 30 issued on the 1st of July that was unpaid as of September 30.

The INFRACTIONS AND DISCIPLINE section included in the Member Handbook which can be found on the member portal in the website, contains details on the revocation and reinstatement process.

STONEWATER MEMBERS PLAYING AT LITTLE MOUNTAIN

Members are invited to play at Little Mountain and can book tee times through the StoneWater or Little Mountain Golf Shops. (440) 358-7888. Tee times can be booked two weeks in advance for all times other than Saturday and Sunday and Monday holidays before 11:00 am. Those times are reserved for Little Mountain Members and are subject to availability one week in advance. StoneWater points cannot be used at Little Mountain. Thus, all StoneWater 15 round members would pay the Little Mountain guest fees for the time/day of week. All unlimited members including those with a StoneWater prepaid cart membership, will be charged full cart fees at the then current Little Mountain rate. The table below shows the rates that will be charged to StoneWater members under various circumstances. The rates will vary based on the time of day and day of week.
